A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In a continuing effort to provide our State's
- 2 veterans with the optimum of care and services in gratitude for
- 3 their sacrifices, the legislature finds that the Yukio Okutsu
- 4 state veterans home may better serve veterans on the island of
- 5 Hawaii if it was transferred from the Hawaii health services
- 6 corporation to the office of veterans' services, along with the
- 7 position (FTE) of state government liaison officer, as required
- 8 by federal law.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to transfer the Yukio Okutsu
- 10 state veterans home from the Hawaii health systems corporation
- 11 to the office of veterans' services, along with the position of
- 12 state government liaison officer.
- 13 SECTION 2. The Yukio Okutsu state veterans home, Hilo,
- 14 Hawaii, is transferred from the department of health, Hawaii
- 15 health systems corporation, to the department of defense, office
- 16 of veterans' services, along with the position (FTE) of state
- 17 government liaison officer.

- 1 SECTION 3. All rights, powers, functions, and duties of 2 the department of health, Hawaii health systems corporation,
- 3 relating to the Yukio Okutsu state veterans home, are
- 4 transferred to the department of defense, office of veterans'
- 5 services.
- 6 All officers and employees whose functions are transferred
- 7 by this Act shall be transferred with their functions and shall
- 8 continue to perform their regular duties upon their transfer,
- 9 subject to the state personnel laws and this Act.
- 10 No officer or employee of the State having tenure shall
- 11 suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service credit,
- 12 vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or privilege as
- 13 a consequence of this Act, and such officer or employee may be
- 14 transferred or appointed to a civil service position without the
- 15 necessity of examination; provided that the officer or employee
- 16 possesses the minimum qualifications for the position to which
- 17 transferred or appointed; and provided that subsequent changes
- 18 in status may be made pursuant to applicable civil service and
- 19 compensation laws.
- 20 An officer or employee of the State who does not have
- 21 tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil
- 22 service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a

- 1 civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority,
- 2 prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee
- 3 benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
- 4 provided that such officer or employee possesses the minimum
- 5 qualifications for the position to which transferred or
- 6 appointed.
- 7 If an office or position held by an officer or employee
- 8 having tenure is abolished, the officer or employee shall not
- 9 thereby be separated from public employment, but shall remain in
- 10 the employment of the State with the same pay and classification
- 11 and shall be transferred to some other office or position for
- 12 which the officer or employee is eligible under the personnel
- 13 laws of the State as determined by the head of the department or
- 14 the governor.
- 15 SECTION 4. All appropriations, records, equipment,
- 16 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents,
- 17 maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used,
- 18 acquired, or held by the department of health, Hawaii health
- 19 systems corporation, relating to the functions transferred to
- 20 the department of defense, office of veterans' services, shall
- 21 be transferred with the functions to which they relate.



- SECTION 5. It is the intent of this Act not to jeopardize 1
- 2 the receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of
- the State or any agency thereof to the holders of any bond 3
- issued by the State or by any such agency, and to the extent, 4
- and only to the extent, necessary to effectuate this intent, the 5
- governor may modify the strict provisions of this Act, but shall 6
- 7 promptly report any such modification with reasons therefor to
- 8 the legislature at its next session thereafter for review by the
- 9 legislature.

10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2010.
