A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE SMALL BOAT HARBORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 200-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

 "(d) The department shall not renew or issue a permit to a

 person who is not the owner of the vessel which is moored or
- 5 which the person desires to moor in a state small boat harbor.
- 6 Any individual who is an owner of a vessel used for commercial
- 7 purposes, including commercial fishing as a principal means of
- 8 livelihood, and possesses a valid mooring permit or commercial
- 9 permit, or both, in accordance with the rules adopted by the
- 10 chairperson pursuant to chapter 91, may transfer ownership of
- 11 the vessel from personal ownership to corporate or other
- 12 business ownership without terminating the right to moor or
- 13 operate the vessel under the permit or permits. The existing
- 14 permit or permits shall be reissued in the name of the
- 15 transferee corporation or other business entity.
- 16 For the purposes of this section, "person" means any
- 17 individual, firm, partnership, corporation, trust, association,

- 1 joint venture, organization, institution, or any other legal 2 entity, and "owner" includes the legal owner of a vessel where 3 there is no security interest held by anyone on the vessel, a 4 buyer under a purchase money security interest, a debtor under 5 any security interest, a demise charterer of a vessel, or a 6 lessee or charterer of a vessel under a lease or charter which 7 provides the lessee or charterer with exclusive right to 8 possession of the vessel to the exclusion of the lessor or the 9 person from whom the vessel is chartered. No permittee shall be 10 allowed to moor a leased vessel in a berth unless the terms of 11 the lease are set at fair market value. A "legal owner" 12 includes a person who holds unencumbered title to a vessel or is 13 a secured party under a security interest in the vessel. An
- owner who is issued a permit to moor a vessel in a state small boat harbor shall notify the department in writing of a transfer of interest or possession in the vessel within seven days of transfer.
- Any person owning an interest in a corporation or other
 business entity [possessing] that possesses a valid commercial
 permit issued by the department, in accordance with rules
 adopted by the chairperson pursuant to chapter 91, or is engaged
 in the business of commercial fishing as its primary business
