A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSERVATION AND RESOURCES ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1	. Chapter 199, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by add	ling a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as	follows:
4	" <u>§</u> 199-	Conservation and resources enforcement special
5	fund; establis	hed. (a) There is hereby established in the
6	treasury of th	ne State a special fund known as the conservation
7	and resources	enforcement special fund, which shall be
8	administered b	by the department of land and natural resources.
9	(b) The	following shall be deposited into the conservation
10	and resources	enforcement special fund:
11	<u>(1)</u> Gran	its, awards, donations, gifts, and transfers of
12	mone	eys derived from public or private sources for the
13	purp	ooses of enforcing the provisions of title 12,
14	<u>char</u>	ters 6D, 6E, and 6K, or any rule adopted
15	ther	reunder;
16	<u>(2)</u> Fees	, reimbursements, administrative charges, and
17	pena	lties collected for activities related to the



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1		enforcement of natural, cultural, and historic		
2		resources protection laws and rules;		
3	(3)	Moneys derived from interest, dividends, or other		
4		income from the above sources; and		
5	(4)	Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund.		
6	(c)	Moneys in the conservation and resources enforcement		
7	special fund shall be expended for activities related to:			
8	(1)	The enforcement of title 12, chapters 6D, 6E, and 6K,		
9		or any rule adopted thereunder; and		
10	(2)	Work performed in cooperation with enforcement		
11		authorities of the State, the counties, and the		
12		federal government,		
13	including training, research, equipment, preparation and			
14	dissemination of information to the public, data collection and			
15	development, information technology, safety, wireless			
16	communication, management, travel, equipment rental, repairs,			
17	planning, information, education, operations, maintenance			
18	functions authorized and deemed necessary by the department of			
19	land and natural resources, and funding for consultants or			
20	contractual hires.			
21	(d) The fund shall be held separate and apart from all			
22	other moneys, funds, and accounts in the department of land and			
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1	natural resources, except that any moneys received from the		
2	federal government or from private contributions shall be		
3	deposited and accounted for in accordance with conditions		
4	established by the department of land and natural resources and		
5	agencies or persons from whom the moneys are received. Any		
6	balance remaining in the fund at the end of any fiscal year		
7	shall be carried forward in the fund for the next fiscal year."		
8	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the conservation		
9	and resources enforcement special fund the sum of \$250,000 or so		
10	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for		
11	the purposes of covering expenses related to enforcing natural,		
12	cultural, and historic resources protection laws and rules.		
13	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
14	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.		
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
