## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the conservation
- 8 and resources enforcement special fund the sum of \$250,000 or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for
- 10 the purposes of covering expenses related to enforcing natural,
- 11 cultural, and historic resources protection laws and rules.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
