BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Over the past several years, the Hawaii teacher 2 standards board has worked to electronically interface with 3 public and private Hawaii teacher education institutions and the 4 department of education to share information about licensed 5 The board's goal is to receive data from these 6 institutions and agencies in a way that expedites operations and 7 avoids the duplicative collection of data by multiple institutions and agencies. In accordance with the federal 8 9 Higher Education Opportunity Act, data sharing between the State 10 and higher education institutions is now federally mandated. 11 addition, data sharing will enable all parties to expedite the 12 performance of their duties and responsibilities.
