A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
 federal Reed Act moneys to the department of labor and
 industrial relations for the following initiatives:

4 As seed moneys to the department of labor and (1)5 industrial relations to be used by the department of labor and industrial relations, in consultation with 6 the local workforce investment boards of each of the 7 8 four counties, to plan, develop, and implement a 9 computer system that benefits workforce development 10 activities and programs operated by the counties; 11 (2) To provide funds to assist the State's four local 12 workforce investment boards. The funds will be used 13 by the local boards to improve employer outreach and 14 services, labor force pool expansion, capacity 15 building, and to fund some shared costs for the 16 operations of the one-stop career centers through the 17 following:
