## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) The examiner of drivers may waive the knowledge test
- 4 required under subsections (a)(2) and (a)(3) and the actual
- 5 demonstration of ability to operate a motor vehicle for any
- 6 person who is at least eighteen years of age and who possesses a
- 7 valid driver's license issued to the applicant in any other
- 8 state of the United States, the District of Columbia, the
- 9 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, a province of
- 10 the Dominion of Canada, [ex] the Commonwealth of the Northern
- 11 Mariana Islands, Republic of Palau, Federated States of
- 12 Micronesia, and the Republic of the Marshall Islands for the
- 13 operation of vehicles in categories 1 through 3 of section
- **14** 286-102."
- 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

- 2 provided that the amendments made to section 286-108, Hawaii
- 3 Revised Statutes, by this Act shall not be repealed when that
- 4 section is reenacted on January 9, 2011, pursuant to section 15
- 5 of Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005.

## Description:

Permits the examiner of drivers to waive the test of knowledge of the rules of the road for applicants holding a valid driver's license from another state of the United States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, a province of the Dominion of Canada, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Republic of Palau, Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of the Marshall Islands.
