BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

    their respective jurisdictions restrict or prohibit the use of

    [such] bicycle paths by mopeds. Signs clearly visible to an

    ordinarily observant person indicating the restriction or

    prohibition shall be placed along bicycle paths so designated

    and every moped driver shall obey the directions thereof. A

Moped & Motor Scooter Helmet Requirements; Bike Lane and Path Restrictions

Description:

Makes it mandatory that persons operating or riding a moped or motor scooter on any highway shall wear a safety helmet with a chin strap. Prohibits three-wheeled mopeds from using bike lanes and bike paths.
