RELATING TO GOVERNMENT RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that government agency
 compliance with the disclosure requirements of the uniform
 informational practices Act is inconsistent and frustrates the
 public.

5 The legislature further finds that requiring a government
6 agency to keep a record of requests for disclosure of government
7 records will enhance compliance with the requirements of the
8 Uniform Informational Practices Act.

9 The purpose of this Act is to require government agencies
10 to keep a record of requests for disclosure of government
11 records.

SECTION 2. Section 92F-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

14 "(b) Except as provided in section 92F-13, each agency 15 upon request by any person shall make government records 16 available for inspection and copying during regular business 17 hours. The agency shall keep a written record of each request



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1	by any person; provided that the written record shall include
2	the following information, at minimum:
3	(1) The specific government record requested;
4	(2) The date the request was made;
5	(3) Whether the agency granted or denied the request; and
6	(4) If the request was denied, the basis for the denial.
7	The written record shall constitute a government record that
8	shall be disclosed upon request."
9	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
