A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify the
- 2 intent of the Sunshine Law with regard to permitted interactions
- 3 among board members and continuances of meetings.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 92-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "§92-2.5 Permitted interactions of members. (a) Two
- 7 members of a board may discuss between themselves matters
- 8 relating to official board business to enable them to perform
- 9 their duties faithfully, as long as no commitment to vote is
- 10 made or sought and the two members do not constitute a quorum of
- 11 their board.
- 12 (b) Two or more members of a board, but less than the
- 13 number of members [which] that would constitute a quorum for the
- 14 board, may be assigned to:
- 15 (1) Investigate a matter relating to the official business
- of their board; provided that:

- 1 the board's officers may be conducted in private without
- 2 limitation or subsequent reporting.
- 3 (d) Discussions between the governor and one or more
- 4 members of a board may be conducted in private without
- 5 limitation or subsequent reporting; provided that the discussion
- 6 does not relate to a matter over which a board is exercising its
- 7 adjudicatory function.
- 8 (e) Discussions between two or more members of a board and
- 9 the head of a department to which the board is administratively
- 10 assigned may be conducted in private without limitation;
- 11 provided that the discussion is limited to matters specified in
- 12 section 26-35.
- (f) Communications, interactions, discussions,
- 14 investigations, and presentations described in this section are
- 15 not meetings for purposes of this part.
- 16 (g) No board member may distribute or disseminate written
- 17 memoranda or written communications related to proposed
- 18 amendments to proposals under deliberation and decisionmaking by
- 19 the board to other members of the board in advance of a public
- 20 meeting, unless copies of those written memoranda or written
- 21 communications are also made available to the public."



1 SECTION 3. Section 92-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 3 No board shall change the agenda, once filed, by 4 adding items thereto without a two-thirds recorded vote of all 5 members to which the board is entitled; provided that no item 6 shall be added to the agenda if it is of reasonably major 7 importance and action thereon by the board will affect a 8 significant number of persons. Items of reasonably major 9 importance not decided at a scheduled meeting shall be 10 considered only at a second meeting continued to a reasonable day and time. If any further continuance is needed, the board 11 12 shall provide written public notice of the continuance as 13 required under this section." 14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 16 SECTION 5. 17 INTRODUCED BY: By Request
