## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 342F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
 and to read as follows:

4 "§342F- Sound devices; prohibitions. (a) It shall be 5 unlawful for any person to play, use, operate, or permit to be played, used, or operated, any radio, tape recorder, cassette 6 7 player, or other machine or device for reproducing sound, if the 8 sound generated is audible at a distance of fifty feet from the 9 device producing the sound and the device is located in or on 10 any: 11 (1) Public property, including any public street, highway, 12 building, sidewalk, park, or thoroughfare; or

13 (2) Motor vehicle on a public street, highway, or public
14 space.

Possession by a person or persons of any of the machines or
devices enumerated in this subsection shall be prima facie

Noise; Sound Devices; Prohibitions; Citation; Penalties

#### Description:

Makes it unlawful for a person to play, use, or operate a radio, tape recorder, cassette player or other machine or device for reproducing sound, if the sound generated is audible at a distance of fifty feet and the device is located in or on any public property or motor vehicle on a public street, highway, or public space; establishes penalties.
