A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOSTER CARE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 2 human services has not raised the monthly board rate for foster care services since 1990, almost twenty years ago. The 3 4 legislature further finds that the current monthly board rate of 5 \$529 for all children regardless of age is insufficient, due to 6 increased costs for food, housing, utilities, clothing, and 7 other necessities. 8 The purpose of this Act is to increase the monthly board 9 rate for foster care services for children. 10 SECTION 2. The department of human services shall increase the rate of the monthly board payment made by the department 11 12 directly to foster boarding home parents, group homes, and child 13 caring institutions under section 17-828-6(d)(2)(A) and (B), 14 Hawaii Administrative Rules, to \$ 15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for 18 the purposes of this Act.

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 2 human services for the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 4. The department of human services shall submit 4 an initial report to the legislature on the status and costs of 5 implementing this Act, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2010 regular session. 6 7 The department shall submit a final report to the legislature on the status of the implementation of this Act, 8 9 annual cost of implementation, anticipated future costs, and 10 number of foster children affected no later than twenty days 11 prior to the convening of the 2011 regular session. 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009. 13
