A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that recent neuroscience research demonstrates that a child's early years are the most crucial in the child's cognitive, emotional, social, and
- 4 physical development.
- 5 The legislature further finds that early screening of
- 6 hearing- and vision-related medical problems improves children's
- 7 outcomes and has a critical influence on school success and
- ${f 8}$ family functioning. As not all children have access to quality
- 9 primary health care, it is in the State's interest to provide
- 10 screening and assessment that will detect hearing and vision
- 11 deficiencies to identify children who are in need of further
- 12 evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment. Early identification and
- 13 treatment can prevent or at least alleviate many of the problems
- 14 that result from impaired hearing or vision.
- 15 The department of health currently provides various
- 16 community health screening services. The purpose of this Act is
- 17 to appropriate moneys to provide screening for hearing and

- 1 vision related conditions throughout childhood and into the
- 2 teenage years.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for
- 6 the screening program mandated under section 321-101, Hawaii
- 7 Revised Statutes.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. The department of health shall partner with the
- 11 department of education, and community service organizations,
- 12 which may include the International Association of Lions Clubs,
- 13 and Rotary Clubs, in order to carry out the hearing and vision
- 14 screening required under this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
