A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that children whose
- 2 parents are engaged in a high conflict divorce suffer from
- 3 behavioral, social, and emotional maladjustment. Research finds
- 4 that when parents are able to cooperate, disengage from their
- 5 conflict with each other, and support the child's relationship
- 6 with the other parent, their children are more productive,
- 7 better adjusted, and more emotionally secure.
- 8 Pursuant to Senate Resolution No. 10 (2007), the senate
- 9 committee on human services and public housing formed the family
- 10 court legal interventions working group to study the
- 11 recommendations made by prior committees dedicated to studying
- 12 methods of family court intervention and best practices for
- 13 children in the family court system.
- 14 The working group evaluated the parenting plan mediation
- 15 pilot program, which aims to assist parents to develop a
- 16 parenting plan without and prior to family court intervention.
- 17 The goal of the pilot program is to shorten the amount of time

- it takes for divorcing couples to reach custody agreements and 1
- 2 reduce the chances of recurring conflict.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to implement the recommendation
- 4 of the family court legal interventions working group by
- 5 providing funding for a parenting plan mediation pilot program.
- 6 There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$85,000 or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
- 9 sum of \$85,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 10 year 2010-2011 for the purpose of developing the parenting plan
- 11 mediation pilot program.
- 12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary on
- 13 a grant executed in accordance with chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
- 14 Statutes, with Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii for
- 15 implementation of the parenting plan mediation pilot program.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
