A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEWBORN SCREENING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 321-291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$321-291 [Tests for phenylketonuria, hypothyroidism, and 4 other metabolic diseases.] Newborn screening for certain 5 diseases, disorders, and deficiencies. (a) The department of 6 health [may] shall specify diseases, disorders, and deficiencies 7 to be screened for in newborn infants and methods to be employed 8 to best prevent mortality and morbidity within the population of 9 the State. Among the diseases, disorders, and deficiencies so 10 specified, the department shall also screen for: 11 (1) Defects of biopterin cofactor biosynthesis; 12 (2) Defects of biopterin cofactor regeneration; 13 (3) Dienoyl-CoA reductase; 14 Galactose epimerase; (4)15 (5) Galactokinase; Medium/short chain L-3-hydroxy acyl-CoA dehydrogenase; 16 (6) 17 (7)Medium-chain ketoacyl-CoA thiolase; and 18 Tyrosinemia type III."
