## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE HAWAII COUNTY ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY COUNCIL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii County
- 2 Economic Opportunity Council is a private nonprofit organization
- 3 established in 1965 whose sole purpose is to serve the low-
- 4 income population in the county of Hawaii. Specifically, the
- 5 agency has provided county-wide transportation services for
- 6 disadvantaged persons for more than thirty-three years and is
- 7 also the only agency in the county that provides transportation
- 8 exclusively for low-income persons.
- 9 The legislature further finds that the agency needs to
- 10 replace ten transportation vehicles to continue to transport the
- 11 county's low-income population to and from public and private
- 12 service facilities.
- Accordingly, the legislature finds that appropriating funds
- 14 to the Hawaii County Economic Opportunity Council for the
- 15 purchase of buses to serve the disadvantaged elderly, pre-school
- 16 children, and disabled persons throughout the county is an
- 17 appropriation for a public purpose.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is provide funding for ten buses
- 2 for the Hawaii County Economic Opportunity Council; provided
- 3 that the funding amounts are subject to change if federal
- 4 funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009,
- 5 Pub.L. 111-5, can be used in lieu of the appropriation in this
- 6 Act.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 as a
- 10 grant-in-aid pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 11 to the Hawaii County Economic Opportunity Council to purchase
- 12 ten new buses to serve the disadvantaged elderly, pre-school
- 13 children, and disabled persons; provided that the appropriation
- 14 shall not be expended if federal funding under the American
- 15 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. 111-5, can be
- 16 used in lieu of the appropriation in this Act.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2099.
