### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$132D- Fireworks surcharge. (a) There is levied and
- 5 assessed at the wholesale and retail levels on every sale of
- 6 consumer fireworks made pursuant to this chapter, a fireworks
- 7 surcharge equal to per cent of the amount collected from
- 8 the sale.
- 9 Payment of the surcharge to the State shall be the
- 10 responsibility of persons licensed under section 132D-7 who sell
- 11 consumer fireworks.
- 12 (b) The department of taxation shall prescribe necessary
- 13 forms and may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to administer
- 14 and effectuate this section."
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending the definition of "cultural" to read as
- 17 follows:

1 ""Cultural" means relating to the arts, customs, 2 traditions, mores, and history of all of the various ethnic 3 groups of Hawaii[-] and includes religious events held in the 4 State." SECTION 3. Section 132D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 6 amended to read as follows: 7 "\$132D-3 Permissible uses of consumer fireworks. 8 fireworks may be set off, ignited, discharged, or otherwise 9 caused to explode within the State only: 10 From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New (1)11 Year's Day; from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Chinese New 12 Year's Day; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the 13 Fourth of July; or 14 (2)From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit 15 pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural 16 use is to occur at any time other than during the 17 periods prescribed in paragraph (1) [+ **18** provided that the purchase of not more than five thousand 19 individual consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers 20 shall be allowed under each permit]." 21 SECTION 4. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 22 amended to read as follows:

Section 132D-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows: 6 7 Except as provided in subsection (a) or as otherwise "(b) 8 specifically provided for in this chapter, any person violating 9 any other provision of this chapter, shall be fined not more 10 than [\$2,000] \$10,000 for each violation. 11 The court shall collect the fines imposed in **12** subsections (a) and (b) for violating this chapter and [of the] transfer all fines collected [shall pay twenty per cent to the 13 State and eighty per cent to the county in which the fine was 14 imposed which shall be expended by the county for law **15** 16 enforcement purposes.] into the general fund." **17** SECTION 6. (a) The state fire council shall conduct a study to determine the negative effects from the use of **18** 19 fireworks in the State. The study shall include the costs 20 incurred by public agencies responding to fireworks incidents,

#### Report Title:

Fireworks; State Fire Council; Surcharge

#### Description:

Increases the fee to purchase consumer fireworks. Generally, increases the penalty for fireworks violations. Transfers all proceeds collected from fireworks violations to the state. Requires a study on the negative effects of the use of fireworks in the State. Includes religious events in the definition of "cultural". Imposes a graduated fireworks fee system to discourage large purchases of fireworks.
