# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103-55.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended as follows:

By amending its title and subsection (a) to read: 3 1. "[+]\$103-55.6[+] Public works construction; apprenticeship 4 agreement. (a) A governmental body, as defined in section 5 103D-104, that enters into a public works contract under this 6 7 chapter having an estimated value of not less than \$250,000, shall decrease the bid amount of a bidder by five per cent if 8 the bidder, or a subcontractor employed by the bidder, is a 9 10 party to an apprenticeship agreement registered with the department of labor and industrial relations for each 11 12 apprenticeable trade the bidder or subcontractor will employ to construct the public works, and in conformance with chapter 372. 13 The lowest total bid, taking the preference into consideration, 14 15 shall be awarded the contract unless the solicitation provides for additional award criteria. The contract amount awarded, 16

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1 however, shall be the amount of the price offered, exclusive of 2 the preference." 3 2. By amending subsections (c) and (d) to read: 4 "(c) At the time of submission of a competitive sealed bid 5 or a competitive sealed proposal by a bidder, the bidder shall furnish written proof [of being] that the bidder or a 6 7 subcontractor employed by the bidder, if applicable, is a party 8 to a registered apprenticeship agreement for each apprenticeable trade the bidder or the subcontractor will employ to construct 9 10 the public works and, if awarded the contract, shall continue to 11 certify monthly in writing that the bidder or subcontractor, if applicable, is a party to a registered apprenticeship agreement 12 13 for each apprenticeable trade the bidder or subcontractor will 14 employ to construct the public works for the entire duration of the bidder's work on the project. This subsection shall be 15 16 deemed to be incorporated into a public works contract. A bidder who is awarded a contract shall be subject to the 17 18 following sanctions if, after commencement of work, the bidder 19 or a subcontractor employed by the bidder at any time during the 20 construction is no longer a party to a registered apprenticeship 21 agreement for each apprenticeable trade the bidder or the 22 subcontractor will employ to construct the public works: 2010-0981 SB2061 SD1 SMA.doc

### Description:

Permits bidders and their subcontractors who are registered under an apprenticeship agreement with DLIR to benefit from a 5% reduction in their bid amount on contracts for \$250,000 or more. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

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
