BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated

within twenty-four hours of the death. 2 The report in subsection (a) shall include the 3 following information: 4 (1)The name of the decedent; 5 (2) Whether the decedent is an inmate or employee; 6 The location of the incident; (3) 7 (4)The date and time of the death; and (5) 8 The cause of death; provided that the director shall have the discretion to withhold 9 **10** disclosure of the decedent's name pending notification of the 11 death to the next of kin or if the decedent's identity is 12 protected from disclosure by state or federal laws." 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. **14** SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
