RELATING TO CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:

8	(1)	Correctional facility or community correctional center

11		inmates reside or who sustain an injury on the grounds
12		of a correctional facility or community correctional
13		center where Hawaii inmates reside that causes the
14		death of the employee; and
15	(2)	Any Hawaii inmate who is incarcerated in a
16		correctional facility or community correctional

1 within twenty-four hours of the death. 2 The report in subsection (a) shall include the 3 following information: 4 (1) The name of the decedent; 5 (2) Whether the decedent is an inmate or employee; 6 (3) The location of the incident; 7 The date and time of the death; and (4)8 (5) The cause of death; 9 provided that the director shall have the discretion to withhold **10** disclosure of the decedent's name pending notification of the 11 death to the next of kin or if the decedent's identity is **12** protected from disclosure by state or federal laws." 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
