A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LITTER CONTROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 339-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
"(a) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, any
person violating any provision of this chapter or any rule
adopted under this chapter shall be guilty of a violation, and
shall be fined not less than \$100, and not more than $[\$500]$
\$1,000 for each offense, and ordered to pick up and remove
litter from a public place under the supervision of the director
as follows:
(1) For the first offense, the violator shall spend four
hours of either picking up litter or performing
community service; and
(2) For any subsequent offense, the violator shall spend
eight hours of either picking up litter or performing
community service.
If the fine under this subsection was issued by a county agency,
the fine shall be deposited into that county's general fund. If

- 2 fine shall be deposited into a special account within the

- 6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 8 begun before its effective date.

- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
