### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In 1999, the legislature established the
- 2 emergency and budget reserve fund as a temporary supplemental
- 3 source of funding for the State of Hawaii in times of emergency,
- 4 economic downturn, or unforeseen reduction in revenues. As set
- 5 forth in section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, specific
- 6 purposes for the fund include the maintaining of levels of
- 7 programs determined to be essential to public health, safety,
- 8 welfare, and education.
- 9 The legislature finds that the national and global economic
- 10 crisis has led to significant economic problems in numerous
- 11 industries in the State, including the airline, cruise ship,
- 12 tourist, and construction industries. Furthermore, recent
- 13 forecasts show that the situation will worsen with a continued
- 14 decline in jobs, personal income, and visitor arrivals, and with
- 15 rising inflation.
- 16 Difficult economic times and declining tax revenues have
- 17 resulted in budget cuts for all state services. State



- 1 departments have been asked to lower their budget proposals by
- 2 up to twenty per cent.
- 3 The current and impending situation jeopardizes the safety
- 4 net of basic human services, health, and education needs for
- 5 Hawaii's residents and families. And while all of Hawaii's
- 6 residents will be affected by the situation, gap group families
- 7 and families closest to the poverty line will suffer the most.
- 8 The legislature finds that expenditures from the emergency
- 9 and budget reserve fund established by section 328L-3, Hawaii
- 10 Revised Statutes, are needed to meet the conditions of
- 11 emergency, economic downturn, and unforeseen reduction in
- 12 revenues that the State currently faces. Further, the
- 13 legislature finds that the appropriations in this Act are
- 14 consistent with the purposes of the emergency and budget reserve
- 15 fund.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys from the
- 17 emergency and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii to
- 18 maintain the levels of programs determined to be essential to
- 19 education, public health, and public welfare.
- 20 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 21 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 22 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



- 1 year 2010-2011 for the department of health, pursuant to section
- 2 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 6 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 7 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 8 year 2010-2011 for the department of human services, pursuant to
- 9 section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 11 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 13 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 14 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 15 year 2010-2011 for the department of education, pursuant to
- 16 section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 20 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 21 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 22 year 2010-2011, pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised

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- 1 Statutes, to supplement the development of Ke Ola Pono, the
- 2 chronic disease self-management program, and enhanced fitness
- 3 statewide.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 5 office on aging for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 7 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 8 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 9 year 2010-2011 for implementation of a respite services program,
- 10 pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 14 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 15 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 16 year 2010-2011 to supplement the healthy start program, pursuant
- 17 to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 21 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$
- 22 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-



- 1 2011, pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes,
  2 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
  3 Revised Statutes, to be distributed as follows:
- 4 (1) Catholic Charities Hawaii \$
- 5 (2) Kapahulu center \$
- 6 (3) Moiliili community center \$
- 7 (4) Waikiki community center \$
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 11 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 12 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 13 year 2010-2011 for the purposes of maintaining kupuna care
- 14 services at the level of service provided statewide in fiscal
- 15 year 2007-2008, pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised
- 16 Statutes.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 20 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 21 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 22 year 2010-2011, pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised



- 1 Statutes, to supplement the development of the aging and
- 2 disability resource center program as follows:
- 3 (1) Provide start-up funds for two new pilot sites for
- 4 Maui and Kauai, and continue the coordination of
- 5 Hawaii and Honolulu counties, which have also
- 6 initiated plans for additional satellite sites on
- 7 their respective islands. This includes aging and
- 8 disability resource center staff positions for each
- 9 county pilot site for project coordination and
- management and administrative support;
- 11 (2) Purchase additional management information system
- 12 products and expand telephone systems. This includes
- software licensing renewals, server clusters,
- installation, staff training, computer hardware,
- 15 technical support, and consultation for website and
- 16 management information system maintenance and
- 17 enhancements;
- 18 (3) Coordinate and implement the aging and disability
- 19 resource center consumer education and outreach
- 20 campaigns. This includes outreach coordination, the
- 21 production and printing of aging and disability
- resource center brochures and printed materials,



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1		posters, media advertisements (print, television, and
2		radio), presentations and exhibits at senior and
3		disability events or focal centers, bilingual
4		translation, and other promotional activities that
5		will educate consumers and the public about aging and
6		disability resource center services; and
7	(4)	Continue the state-level coordination and evaluation
8		activities of the project. This includes an
9		appropriation for the positions of project
10		coordinator, project evaluator consultant, research
11		assistant, and administrative support.
12	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
13	health for the purposes of this Act.	
14	SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the emergency and	
15	budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of	
16	\$	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17	year 2010-2011 for the developmental disabilities medicaid	
18	waiver program, pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised	
19	Statutes.	
20	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of	
21	health for the purposes of this Act.	

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- 1 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 4 year 2010-2011 for mental health services, pursuant to section
- 5 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 11 year 2010-2011 for the partnerships in community living program,
- 12 pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 14. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 16 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 17 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 18 year 2010-2011 for direct health care to the uninsured, which
- 19 may include primary medical, dental, and behavioral health care,
- 20 pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 22 health for the purposes of this Act.



- 1 SECTION 15. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 4 year 2010-2011 for substance abuse treatment, pursuant to
- 5 section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 11 year 2010-2011 for the healthy aging partnership program,
- 12 pursuant to section 328L-3(d)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 17. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
- 16 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 17 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 18 year 2010-2011 for the Hawaii children's health care program,
- 19 established pursuant to Act 236, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



- SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 1
- budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii as a grant pursuant 2
- to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$ 3
- or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 4
- for the Hawaii Immigrant Health Initiative Program services 5
- 6 administered by the Kalihi-Palama Health Center.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 7
- human services for the purposes of this Act. 8
- SECTION 19. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010. 9
