BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 353C-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]§353C-3[+] Deputy directors; appointment. (a) The
- 4 director shall appoint, without regard to chapter 76, three
- 5 deputy directors to serve at the director's pleasure. [Unless
- 6 otherwise assigned by the director, one] One deputy director
- 7 shall oversee the correctional programs and facilities of the
- 8 department, one deputy director shall oversee the law
- 9 enforcement programs of the department, and one deputy director
- 10 shall oversee administration of the department.
- 11 (b) The deputy director for law enforcement shall be a
- 12 graduate of either a law enforcement academy or a law school;
- 13 provided that any person appointed as deputy director for law
- 14 enforcement prior to July 1, 2009, and serving in that capacity
- 15 on the effective date of this Act shall not be required to be a
- 16 graduate of a law enforcement academy or a law school."

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.

Description:

Requires the deputy director for law enforcement within the department of public safety to be a graduate of a law enforcement academy or a law school; provided that the requirement shall not be applied retroactively to persons appointed prior to July 1, 2009.
