A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to article 10A, part I to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§431:10A- Drug formulary board. (a) No insurer that
5	provides individual and group accident and health and sickness
6	insurance policies and that bases coverage for prescription
7	drugs on a drug formulary or prior authorization requirement
8	shall employ a drug formulary or prior authorization requirement
9	for prescription drug coverage in Hawaii unless the formulary or
10	authorization requirement has been developed by a drug formulary
11	board. At least a majority of the members of the drug formulary
12	board shall be Hawaii residents or shall currently be practicing
13	in this State.
14	(b) Each drug formulary board shall establish a
15	prescription drug formulary and prior authorization requirement
16	for the insurer with which the drug formulary board is
17	associated. Each drug formulary board shall meet at least two
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1	times per calendar year to review and update the drug formulary
2	and prior authorization requirements and shall base their
3	recommendations on analysis of drug safety and efficacy using
4	appropriate medical and scientific evidence.
5	(c) Each insurer subject to this section shall establish
6	its own rules and policies to govern the drug formulary board.
7	Rules and policies governing the drug formulary board shall be
8	included with each rate filing submitted to the commissioner
9	pursuant to subsection (d).
10	(d) Each insurer shall file the prescription drug
11	formulary and prior authorization requirement established and
12	each update to the prescription drug formulary and prior
13	authorization requirement enacted pursuant to subsection (b)
14	with the commissioner as a rate filing subject to chapter
15	<u>431:14G.</u>
16	(e) For purposes of this section:
17	"Prescription drug formulary" means a list of prescription
18	drugs for which an insurer provides coverage at a defined
19	benefit level either directly to a policy holder or indirectly
20	through a contractual relationship with another corporate entity
21	such as a pharmacy benefits manager.

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1	"Prior authorization requirement" means an insurer's
2	requirement for specific and individualized approval by the
3	insurer before certain prescription drugs are covered at any
4	benefit level by a policy of accident and health and sickness
5	insurance."
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by adding a new section to article 10A, part II to be
8	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
9	"§431:10A- Drug formulary board. (a) No insurer that
10	provides group and blanket disability insurance and that bases
11	coverage for prescription drugs on a drug formulary or prior
12	authorization requirement shall employ a drug formulary or prior
13	authorization requirement for prescription drug coverage in
14	Hawaii unless the formulary or authorization requirement has
15	been developed by a drug formulary board. At least a majority
16	of the members of the drug formulary board shall be Hawaii
17	residents or shall currently be practicing in this State.
18	(b) Each drug formulary board shall establish a
19	prescription drug formulary and prior authorization requirement
20	for the insurer with which the drug formulary board is
21	associated. Each drug formulary board shall meet at least two
22	times per calendar year to review and update the drug formulary
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1	and prior authorization requirements and shall base their
2	recommendations on analysis of drug safety and efficacy using
3	appropriate medical and scientific evidence.
4	(c) Each insurer subject to this section shall establish
5	its own rules and policies to govern the drug formulary board.
6	Rules and policies governing the drug formulary board shall be

9	formulary or prior authorization requirement shall employ a drug
10	formulary or prior authorization requirement for prescription
11	drug coverage in Hawaii unless the formulary or authorization
12	requirement has been developed by a drug formulary board. At
13	least a majority of the members of the drug formulary board
14	shall be Hawaii residents or shall currently be practicing in
15	this State.
16	(b) Each drug formulary board shall establish a
17	prescription drug formulary and prior authorization requirement
18	for the mutual benefit society with which the drug formulary
19	board is associated. Each drug formulary board shall meet at
20	least two times per calendar year to review and update the drug
21	formulary and prior authorization requirements and shall base

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1	their recommendations on analysis of drug safety and efficacy
2	using appropriate medical and scientific evidence.
3	(c) Each mutual benefit society subject to this section
4	shall establish its own rules and policies to govern the drug
5	formulary board. Rules and policies governing the drug
6	formulary board shall be included with each rate filing
7	submitted to the commissioner pursuant to subsection (d).

4	amended by adding a new section to article 2 to be appropriately
5	designated and to read as follows:
6	"§432:2- Drug formulary board. (a) No fraternal
7	benefit society that bases coverage for prescription drugs on a
8	drug formulary or prior authorization requirement shall employ a
9	drug formulary or prior authorization requirement for
10	prescription drug coverage in Hawaii unless the formulary or
11	authorization requirement has been developed by a drug formulary
12	board. At least a majority of the members of the drug formulary
13	board shall be Hawaii residents or shall currently be practicing
14	in this State.
15	(b) Each drug formulary board shall establish a
16	prescription drug formulary and prior authorization requirement
17	for the fraternal benefit society with which the drug formulary
18	board is associated. Each drug formulary board shall meet at
19	least two times per calendar year to review and update the drug
20	formulary and prior authorization requirements and shall base
21	their recommendations on analysis of drug safety and efficacy

2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§432D- Drug formulary board. (a) No health
5	maintenance organization that bases coverage for prescription
6	drugs on a drug formulary or prior authorization requirement
7	shall employ a drug formulary or prior authorization requirement
8	for prescription drug coverage in Hawaii unless the formulary or
9	authorization requirement has been developed by a drug formulary
10	board. At least a majority of the members of the drug formulary
11	board shall be Hawaii residents or shall currently be practicing
12	in this State.
13	(b) Each drug formulary board shall establish a
14	prescription drug formulary and prior authorization requirement
15	for the health maintenance organization with which the drug
16	formulary board is associated. Each drug formulary board shall
17	meet at least two times per calendar year to review and update
18	the drug formulary and prior authorization requirements and
19	shall base their recommendations on analysis of drug safety and
20	efficacy using appropriate medical and scientific evidence.
21	(c) Each health maintenance organization subject to this
22	section shall establish its own rules and policies to govern the
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1	drug formulary board. Rules and policies governing the drug
2	formulary board shall be included with each rate filing
3	submitted to the commissioner pursuant to subsection (d).
4	(d) Each health maintenance organization shall file the
5	prescription drug formulary and prior authorization requirement
6	established and each update to the prescription drug formulary
7	and prior authorization requirement enacted pursuant to
8	subsection (b) with the commissioner as a rate filing subject to
9	chapter 431:14G.
10	(e) For purposes of this section:
11	"Prescription drug formulary" means a list of prescription
12	drugs for which a health maintenance organization provides
13	coverage at a defined benefit level either directly to a member
14	or indirectly through a contractual relationship with another
15	corporate entity such as a pharmacy benefits manager.
16	"Prior authorization requirement" means a health
17	maintenance organization's requirement for specific and
18	individualized approval by the health maintenance organization
19	before certain prescription drugs are covered at any benefit
20	level by a policy of accident and health and sickness
21	insurance."
