A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 291-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending the definitions of "issuing agency" and 3 "removable windshield placard" to read: 4 "Issuing agency" means [an agency authorized by a county 5 to issue removable windshield placards, temporary removable 6 windshield placards, special license plates, and identification 7 cards-pursuant to this-part.] the disability and communication 8 access board. 9 "Removable windshield placard" means a two-sided, hanger-10 style placard issued under this part to a person with a 11 disability who presents a certificate of disability that 12 verifies that the applicant's disability is expected to last for 13 at least [four] six years." 14 Section 291-51.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2. 15 amended to read as follows: 16 "§291-51.3 Reimbursement to counties[-]; agreement with 17 counties to provide permits. 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' 1	windshield placard or a temporary removable windshield placard	
2	on behalf of the State. [Beginning-July 1, 2006, the rate of	
3	the per-unit-cost reimbursement-shall be-\$12. All fees	
4	collected by the counties for issuing removable and temporary	
5	removable windshield-placards shall be deposited into the state	
6	general fund.] The reimbursement rate paid to the counties for	
7	providing removable windshield placards, temporary removable	
8	windshield placards, special license plates, and identification	
9	cards shall be established pursuant to section 291-56; provided	
10	that a county may retain any fees charged for a transaction."	
11	SECTION 3. Section 291-51.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
12	amended to read as follows:	
13	"§291-51.5 Special license plates. Upon application by a	
14	person with a disability, [cach county] <u>the issuing agency</u> shall	
15	issue special license plates for the vehicle registered in the	
16	applicant's name if the vehicle is primarily used to transport	
17	that person. The fee for the issuance of special license plates	
18	shall not exceed the fee charged for similar license plates for	
19	the same class vehicle."	

20 SECTION 4. Section 291-51.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 21 amended to read as follows:



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1 "§291-51.6 Issuance of temporary removable windshield placards. [Each county] The issuing agency shall issue one 2 3 temporary removable windshield placard [and a second temporary 4 removable windshield placard] to each applicant who requests and 5 presents a certificate of disability that verifies the duration 6 of the applicant's disability in monthly increments, which shall 7 not exceed six months, and upon payment of a fee to the issuing 8 agency. [All fees collected by the counties for issuing 9 temporary removable windshield placards shall be deposited into 10 the state general fund. The temporary removable windshield 11 placard-shall be designed, fabricated, and sold to the counties 12 at a rate negotiated by the disability and communication access 13 board.] Upon request of an applicant who was previously issued 14 one temporary removable windshield placard, a second temporary removable windshield placard shall be issued to that applicant 15 16 upon verification of the applicant's disability." 17 SECTION 5. Section 291-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

18 amended to read as follows:

19 "§291-52 Issuance of removable windshield placard. [Each
20 county] The issuing agency shall issue one removable windshield
21 placard [and a second removable windshield placard] to each
22 applicant who [so requests and] presents a certificate of
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1 disability that verifies that the applicant's disability is 2 expected to last for at least [four] six years. The removable 3 windshield placard shall expire [four] six years after the date 4 of its issuance. [The removable windshield placard shall be 5 designed, fabricated, and sold to the counties at a rate 6 negotiated by the disability and communication access board.] " SECTION 6. Section 291-52.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 8 amended to read as follows: 9 "§291-52.5 Issuance of identification card. [Each] The 10 issuing agency shall issue one identification card at the same 11 time it issues a removable windshield placard, temporary 12 removable windshield placard, or special license plates to a 13 person with a disability." 14 SECTION 7. Section 291-52.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended to read as follows: 16 "§291-52.6 Replacement of a [lost, stolen, or mutilated] 17 removable windshield placard or identification card. A 18 removable windshield placard, temporary removable windshield placard, or identification card [that is reported lost, stolen, 19 20 or mutilated] shall be replaced upon: 21 Submittal to the issuing agency of [+ (1)



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1	(A) A written statement by a person with a disability
2	that the placard or identification card was
3	either-lost, stolen, or mutilated; and
4	(B) A] <u>a</u> completed application for a removable
5	windshield placard, temporary removable
6	windshield placard, or identification card to the
7	issuing agency; and
8	(2) Payment of a fee [to the issuing agency.
9	All fees collected by the counties for replacement of a lost,
10	stolen, or mutilated removable windshield placard shall be
11	deposited into the state general fund]."
12	SECTION 8. Section 291-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	"§291-56 Rules. The disability and communication access
15	board shall adopt rules under chapter 91 to carry out the
16	purposes of this part, including rules for:
17	(1) The issuance, renewal, confiscation, revocation, and
18	suspension of removable windshield placards, temporary
19	removable windshield placards, and special license
20	plates;
21	(2) Decertification, reciprocity, and the replacement of
22	placards and identification cards;



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1	(3)	The design of the placard, identification card, and
2		special license plates;
3	(4)	The establishment of transaction fees for placards;
4	(5)	Signage and marking of parking spaces; [and]
5	(6)	Reimbursement rates to the counties; and

Description:

Designates the disability and communication access board as issuing agency for removable windshield placards, temporary removable windshield placards, special license plates, and identification cards. Deletes counties as issuing agency. Increases the time period that a placard is effective from four to six years. (CD1)
