A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LÉGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definitions of "issuing agency" and
- 3 "removable windshield placard" to read:
- 4 ""Issuing agency" means [an agency authorized by a county
- 5 to issue removable windshield placards, temporary removable
- 6 windshield placards, special license plates, and identification
- 7 cards pursuant to this part.] the disability and communication
- 8 access board.
- 9 "Removable windshield placard" means a two-sided, hanger-
- 10 style placard issued under this part to a person with a
- 11 disability who presents a certificate of disability that
- 12 verifies that the applicant's disability is expected to last for
- 13 at least [four] six years."
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 291-51.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 "S291-51.3 Reimbursement to counties[-]; agreement with
- 17 counties to provide permits. The State shall reimburse the



- 1 counties for the unit cost of [issuing] providing a removable
