A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows:

By amending the definition of "issuing agency" to read:
 ""Issuing agency" means [an agency authorized by a county
 to issue removable windshield placards, temporary removable
 windshield placards, special license plates, and identification
 cards pursuant to this part.] the disability and communication
 access board."

9 2. By amending the definition of "removable windshield10 placard" to read:

II ""Removable windshield placard" means a two-sided, hangerI2 style placard issued under this part to a person with a
I3 disability who presents a certificate of disability that
I4 verifies that the applicant's disability is expected to last for
I5 at least [four] six years."

16 SECTION 2. Section 291-51.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 amended to read as follows:

1 "§291-51.3 Reimbursement to counties [-]; agreement with 2 counties to provide permits. The State shall reimburse the 3 counties for the unit cost of [issuing] providing a removable windshield placard or a temporary removable windshield placard 4 5 on behalf of the State. [Beginning July 1, 2006, the rate of 6 the per unit cost reimbursement shall be \$12. All fees 7 collected by the counties for issuing removable and temporary 8 removable windshield placards shall be deposited into the state 9 general fund.] The reimbursement rate paid to the counties for 10 providing removable windshield placards, temporary removable 11 windshield placards, special license plates, and identification 12 cards shall be established pursuant to section 291-56; provided 13 that a county may retain any fees charged for a transaction." 14 SECTION 3. Section 291-51.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended to read as follows: 16 "§291-51.5 Special license plates. Upon application by a

17 person with a disability, [each county] the issuing agency shall 18 issue special license plates for the vehicle registered in the 19 applicant's name if the vehicle is primarily used to transport 20 that person. The fee for the issuance of special license plates 21 shall not exceed the fee charged for similar license plates for 22 the same class vehicle."

1 SECTION 4. Section 291-51.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291-51.6 Issuance of temporary removable windshield 4 **placards.** [Each county] The issuing agency shall issue one 5 temporary removable windshield placard [and a second temporary 6 removable windshield placard] to each applicant who requests and 7 presents a certificate of disability that verifies the duration 8 of the applicant's disability in monthly increments, which shall 9 not exceed six months, and upon payment of a fee to the issuing 10 [All fees collected by the counties for issuing agency. 11 temporary removable windshield placards shall be deposited into 12 the state general fund. The temporary removable windshield 13 placard shall be designed, fabricated, and sold to the counties 14 at a rate negotiated by the disability and communication access 15 board.] Upon request of an applicant who was previously issued 16 one temporary removable windshield placard, a second temporary 17 removable windshield placard shall be issued to that applicant 18 upon verification of the applicant's disability." 19 SECTION 5. Section 291-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 20 amended to read as follows:

1 placard [and a second removable windshield placard] to each 2 applicant who [so requests and] presents a certificate of 3 disability that verifies that the applicant's disability is 4 expected to last for at least [four] six years. The removable 5 windshield placard shall expire [four] six years after the date 6 of its issuance. [The removable windshield placard shall be 7 designed, fabricated, and sold to the counties at a rate 8 negotiated by the disability and communication access board.] 9 Upon request of an applicant who was previously issued one 10 removable windshield placard, a second removable windshield 11 placard shall be issued to that applicant upon verification of 12 the applicant's disability." SECTION 6. Section 291-52.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 14 amended to read as follows: 15 "§291-52.5 Issuance of identification card. [Each] The 16 issuing agency shall issue one identification card at the same 17 time it issues a removable windshield placard, temporary 18 removable windshield placard, or special license plates to a 19 person with a disability."

20 SECTION 7. Section 291-52.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
