## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 356D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 3 There is created a board of directors consisting of 4 eleven members, of whom nine shall be public members appointed 5 by the governor as provided in section 26-34. Public members shall be appointed from each of the counties of Honolulu, 6 7 Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai. At least [one] two public [member] 8 members shall be [a person] persons who [is] are directly 9 assisted by the authority under the federal low-rent public 10 housing or federal section 8 tenant-based housing assistance 11 payments program while serving on the board. One public member 12 shall be an advocate for low-income or homeless persons. 13 public member shall be a person with a disability or an advocate 14 for persons with disabilities. The public members of the board 15 shall serve four-year staggered terms; provided that the initial 16 appointments shall be as follows: four members shall be 17 appointed for four years; three members shall be appointed for 18 three years; and two members shall be appointed for two years.
