### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONVEYANCE TAX.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under 4 this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit 5 of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for 6 the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists 7 by law; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year: 8 Ten per cent shall be paid into the land conservation (1)9 fund established pursuant to section 173A-5; 10 (2)Twenty-five per cent from July 1, 2009, until June 30, 11 2012, and thirty per cent in each fiscal year 12 thereafter shall be paid into the rental housing trust fund established by section 201H-202; [and] 13 14 (3) Twenty per cent from July 1, 2009, until June 30, 15 2012, and twenty-five per cent in each fiscal year 16 thereafter shall be paid into the natural area reserve 17 fund established by section 195-9; provided that the



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1		funds paid into the natural area reserve fund shall be
2		annually disbursed by the department of land and
3		natural resources in the following priority:
4		(A) To natural area partnership and forest
5		stewardship programs after joint consultation
6		with the forest stewardship committee and the
7		natural area reserves system commission;
8		(B) Projects undertaken in accordance with watershed
9		management plans pursuant to section 171-58 or
10		watershed management plans negotiated with
11		private landowners, and management of the natural
12		area reserves system pursuant to section 195-3;
13		and
14		(C) The youth conservation corps established under
15		chapter 193[-]; and
16	(4)	per cent shall be paid into a separate account in
17		the state treasury to be expended by the department of
18		education on public school facilities in grades
19		kindergarten through twelve; provided that the
20		department of education shall apportion and disburse
21		funds from the separate account to benefit the school
22		district where the realty, the transfer or conveyance



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1	of which caused the imposition, levy, and collection
2	of taxes under this chapter, is located."
3	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
5	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
