- 1 SECTION 1. Section 612-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§612-27 Rules. The supreme court [is authorized to] may
- 4 adopt, amend, and repeal the rules of court, not inconsistent
- 5 with the policies and objectives [set forth in] of this
- 6 chapter[, regulating] to regulate all aspects of the selection
- 7 and management of grand and trial jurors [, and] by setting forth
- 8 policies, procedures, and forms for the selection and management
- 9 of grand and trial jurors in [the] jury pools, [in] courtrooms,
- 10 and $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$ other appropriate circumstances in furtherance of the
- 11 objectives of this chapter."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
