A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CLUBS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 486N, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§486N- Military personnel; federal active duty
5	deployment outside State; cancellation or suspension of
6	contract. (a) In addition to cancellation of a health club
7	contract under sections 486N-6 and 486N-7, a health club
8	contract of a member of the United States military, including a
9	member of the Hawaii national guard, United State military
10	reserves, or regular United States armed forces who is serving
11	on federal active duty or active duty in federal service and
12	deployed or otherwise serving outside of this State during the
13	term of the contract, may be canceled or suspended provided that
14	the request for cancellation or suspension:
15	(1) Is made by the member or the member's legally
16	designated representative;

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1	(2)	Includes a copy of the member's official military	
2		orders or a written verification from the member's	
3		commanding officer; and	
4	<u>(3)</u>	Is made within ninety days after the member receives	
5		notice of serving on federal active duty or active	
6	N.	duty in federal service and deployment or service	
7		outside of this State.	
8	(b)	If a contract is suspended under this section, the	
9	health cl	ub shall not charge any fees to reinstate the contract	
10	and shall	maintain the original payment obligations set forth in	
11	the origin	nal contract. A contract that is suspended pursuant to	
12	subsection (a) shall be subject to cancellation two years from		
13	the date of suspension if the customer fails to reinstate the		
14	contract.		
15	<u>(c)</u>	If a contract is cancelled under this section, the	
16	health cl	ub may retain the portion of the total contract price	
17	representing the services used plus reimbursement for the		
18	expenses incurred in an amount not to exceed twenty-five per cen		
19	of the to	tal contract price."
