A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL RESIDENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that doctors in medical
- 2 residency programs in Hawaii are not allowed to practice outside
- 3 of the hospitals in which they are serving their residencies.
- 4 However, if the estimated several hundred medical residents in
- 5 Hawaii were allowed to practice within the scope of their
- 6 residency training in settings outside of their hospitals, they
- 7 would provide a convenient and ready pool to ease the shortage
- 8 of medical practitioners in Hawaii, particularly on the neighbor
- 9 islands.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to bring more licensed
- 11 physicians into the physician community to increase access to
- 12 health care.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 453, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 15 and to read as follows:
- 16 "§453- Medical residents practice of medicine outside of
- 17 medical residency program hospital or clinic. (a) A person

1 licensed under this chapter who is a medical resident serving in 2 a medical residency program in a hospital or clinic in this 3 State may engage in the practice of medicine outside of that 4 hospital or clinic. 5 (b) Any contractual restriction or prohibition that 6 prohibits the practice of medicine as specifically allowed by 7 subsection (a) shall be deemed void as a matter of law. 8 (c) As used in this section, the term "medical residency 9 program" refers to graduate medical training. A medical 10 resident is a person who has received a medical degree and who 11 practices medicine in a medical residency program under the **12** supervision of fully licensed physicians, usually in a hospital 13 or clinic. A medical residency may follow the internship year 14 or include the internship year as the first year of residency." SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 15
