A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 421J-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§421J-4 Proxies. [(a) A proxy shall be in writing and
4	shall be valid for only a specified meeting of the association
5	and any adjournments of that meeting.
6	(b) A member of the association may give a proxy to any
7	person or the board of directors as an entity, and the proxy may
8	be limited as indicated by the member. No proxy shall be
9	irrevocable unless:
10	(1) The proxy is coupled with a financial interest in the
11	unit; or
12	(2) The proxy is held pursuant to a first mortgage of
13	record encumbering a unit-or-an-agreement of sale
14	affecting a unit.
15	(c)—To be valid, a proxy shall:
16	(1) Be delivered to the secretary of the association or
17	the managing agent, if any, no later than 4:30 p.m. on

1		the second business day prior to the date of the
2		meeting to which it pertains;
3	(2)	Contain at least the name of the association, the date
4		of the meeting of the association, the printed name
5		and signature of the person or persons giving the
6		proxy, the unit or units for which the proxy is given,
7		and the date that the proxy is given; and
8	-(3-) -	Contain boxes wherein the owner has indicated that the
9		proxy is given:
10		(A) For quorum purposes only;
11		(B) To the individual whose name is printed on a line
12		next to this box;
13		(C) To the board of directors as a whole and that the
14		vote be made on the basis of the preference of
15		the majority of the board; or
16		(D) To those directors present at the meeting and the
17		vote to be shared with each board member
18		receiving an equal percentage.
19	(d)	Any board of directors that uses association funds to
20	distribut	proxies that include the election of directors shall
21	first pos	notice of its intent to distribute proxies in
22	prominent	locations within the project at least thirty days

1	prior to its distribution of proxies; provided that if the board	
2	receives within seven days of the posted notice a request by any	
3	owner for nomination to the board accompanied by a statement,	
4	the board shall mail to all owners either:	
5	(1) A proxy form containing the names of all owners who	
6	have requested nomination to the board accompanied by	
7	their statements; or	
8	(2) A proxy form containing no names, but accompanied by a	
9	list of names of all owners who have requested	
10	nomination to the board and their statements.	
11	The statement shall not exceed one hundred words,	
12	indicating the owner's qualifications to serve on the board and	
13	reasons for wanting to receive proxies.	
14	(e) Nothing in this section shall affect the holder of any	
15	proxy under a first mortgage of record encumbering an apartment	
16	or under an agreement of sale affecting an apartment.	
17	(f) Nothing in this section-shall prohibit the use-of	
18	proxies for filling vacancies that occur after the notice of the	
19	annual meeting has been distributed.] (a) If only one of	
20	several owners of a unit is present at a meeting of the	
21	association, that owner is entitled to cast all the votes	
22	allocated to that unit. If more than one of the owners is

present, the votes allocated to that unit shall be cast only in 1 accordance with the agreement of a majority in interest of the 2 3 owners, unless the declaration or bylaws expressly provide 4 otherwise. There is majority agreement if any one of the owners 5 casts the votes allocated to that unit without protest to the person presiding over the meeting by any of the other owners of 6 the unit before the polls are closed. 7 8 (b) Votes allocated to a unit may be cast pursuant to a proxy duly executed by a unit owner. A unit owner may vote by 9 10 mail or electronic transmission through a duly executed proxy. If a unit is owned by more than one person, each owner of the 11 12 unit may vote or register a protest to the casting of votes by 13 the other owners of the unit through a duly executed proxy. In 14 the absence of a protest, any owner may cast the votes allocated 15 to the unit by proxy. A unit owner may revoke a proxy given 16 pursuant to this section only by actual notice of revocation to **17** the secretary of the association or the managing agent. A proxy is void if it purports to be revocable without notice. 18 (c) No votes allocated to a unit owned by the association 19

shall be cast by proxy for the election or reelection of

4	<u>(e)</u>	A proxy, to be valid, shall:
5	(1)	Be delivered to the secretary of the association or
6		the managing agent, if any, no later than 4:30 p.m.
7		on the second business day prior to the date of the
8		meeting to which it pertains;
9	(2)	Contain at least the name of the association, the date
10		of the meeting of the association, the printed names
11		and signatures of the persons giving the proxy, the
12		unit numbers for which the proxy is given, the names
13		of persons to whom the proxy is given, and the date
14		that the proxy is given; and
15	<u>(3)</u>	If it is a standard proxy form authorized by the
16		association, contain boxes wherein the owner has
17	·	indicated whether the proxy is given:
18		(A) For quorum purposes only;
19		(B) To the individual whose name is printed on a line
20		<pre>next to this box;</pre>
21		(C) To the board as a whole so that the vote is to be
22		made on the basis of the preference of the

1		majority of the directors present at the meeting;
2		<u>or</u>
3	(D)	To those directors present at the meeting so that
4		the vote shall be shared to give each director an
5		equal percentage.
6	(f) A pr	oxy shall be valid only for the meeting to which
7	the proxy pert	ains. A unit owner may designate any person as
8	proxy and may	limit the proxy as the unit owner desires and
9	indicates; pro	vided that no proxy shall be irrevocable unless it
10	is coupled wit	h a financial interest in the unit.
11	(g) A co	py, facsimile telecommunication, or other reliable
12	reproduction o	f a proxy may be used in lieu of the original
13	proxy for any	and all purposes for which the original proxy
14	could have bee	n used; provided that any copy, facsimile
15	telecommunicat	ion, or other reproduction of the proxy shall be a
16	complete repro	duction of the entire original proxy.
17	(h) Noth	ing in this section shall affect the holder of any
18	proxy under a	first mortgage of record encumbering a unit or
19	under an agree	ment of sale affecting a unit.
20	(i) With	respect to the use of association funds to
21	distribute pro	xies:

1	<u>(1)</u>	Any board that intends to use association funds to
2		distribute proxies, including the standard proxy form
3		referred to in subsection (e)(3), shall first post
4		notice in prominent locations within the project of
5		its intent to distribute proxies at least twenty-one
6		days before the distribution of proxies. If, within
7		seven days of the posted notice, the board receives a
8		request by any owner to use association funds to
9		solicit proxies accompanied by a statement, the board
10		shall mail to all owners:
11		(A) A proxy form containing the names of all owners
12		who have requested the use of association funds
13		to solicit proxies accompanied by the owners'
14		statements; or
15		(B) A proxy form containing no names, but accompanied
16		by a list of names and the statements of all
17		owners who have requested the use of association
18		funds to solicit proxies.
19		For purposes of this section, an owner's statement
20		shall be limited to black text on white paper, shall
21		not exceed one single-sided 8-1/2" x 11" page, and

1		shall indicate the owner's qualifications to serve on
2		the board or reasons for wanting to receive proxies;
3	(2)	A board or member may use association funds to solicit
4		proxies as part of the distribution of proxies. If a
5		member of the board, as an individual, seeks to
6		solicit proxies using association funds, the board
7		member shall proceed as a unit owner under paragraph
8		(1); and
9	(3)	An association may comply with this subsection by
10		making information available to unit owners, at the
11	•	option of the owner and at no cost to the unit owner
12		for reviewing or downloading the information through
13		an internet site.
14	<u>(j)</u>	No managing agent, resident manager, or any employee
15	of a mana	ging agent or resident manager shall solicit, for use
16	by the ma	naging agent or resident manager, any proxies from any
17	unit owne	r of the association that retains the managing agent or
18	employs t	he resident manager, nor shall the managing agent or
19	resident :	manager cast any proxy vote at any association meeting
20	except fo	r the purpose of establishing a quorum.
21	(k)	No board shall adopt any rule prohibiting unit owners
22	from soli	citing proxies or distributing materials relating to
		0.000

- 1 association matters on the common elements; provided that a
- 2 board may adopt rules regulating the time, place, and manner of
- 3 the solicitation or distribution of proxies, or both, and the
- 4 reasonableness thereof."
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 421J-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 "[+] \$421J-6[+] Robert's Rules of Order. All association
- 8 and board of directors meetings shall be conducted in accordance
- 9 with the most current edition of Robert's Rules of Order[7]
- 10 Newly Revised."
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 14 provided that the requirements of this Act shall not take effect
- 15 until January 1, 2011.
