## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§150A- Failure to pay or remit the inspection,
5	quarantine, and eradication service fee; fines. (a) The
6	following fines shall be imposed for failure to pay, bill, or
7	remit the inspection, quarantine, and eradication service fee
8	imposed by section 150A-5.3:
9	(1) A person responsible for paying the freight charges to
10	the transportation company who fails to pay the fee
11	shall be assessed a fine of \$100 for every one
12	thousand pounds of freight or part thereof; and
13	(2) A transportation company that fails to:
14	(A) Bill the fee, within fifteen days of the delivery
15	of the freight, to the person responsible for
16	paying the freight charges to the transportation
17	company; or

1	(B) Remit the fee to the department within forty-five
2	days of collecting the fee from the person
3	responsible for paying the freight charges to the
4	transportation company,
5	shall pay a fine of \$100 for every one thousand pounds
6	of freight or part thereof.
7	(b) All fines shall be paid to the department and
8	deposited into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication
9	fund under section 150A-4.5."
10	SECTION 2. Section 150A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
l1	amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
12	inserted and to read as follows:
13	"Cement bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous cement,
14	without mark or count, that is usually free-flowing and bought
15	and sold by weight or volume.
16	"Liquid bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous liquid
17	goods, without mark or count, that are usually free-flowing and
18.	bought and sold by weight or volume, such as oil, or other
19	complex mixture of petroleum hydrocarbons, bituminous liquids
20	such as asphalt, gasoline, and fuel oils."
21	SECTION 3. Section 150A-5.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 1 "§150A-5.3 Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
- 2 fee and charge. There is imposed a fee for the inspection,
- 3 quarantine, and eradication of invasive species contained in any
- 4 freight, including but not limited to marine commercial
- 5 container shipment, air freight, or any other means of
- 6 transporting freight, foreign or domestic, that is brought into
- 7 the State[-], except for liquid bulk freight and cement bulk
- 8 freight. The fee shall be paid by the person responsible for
- 9 paying the freight charges to the transportation company, who
- 10 shall collect the fee and forward the payment to the department
- 11 at the port of disembarkation; provided that the transportation
- 12 company shall not be liable for any fee that is not paid by the
- 13 person responsible for paying the freight charges to the
- 14 transportation company. The department shall deposit the fee
- 15 into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund under
- 16 section 150A-4.5.
- 17 The fee shall be assessed on the net weight of the imported
- 18 freight computed on the basis of 50 cents for every one thousand
- 19 pounds of freight brought into the State, or part thereof."
- 20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
