4	" <u>§707-</u> Assault against a water safety officer. (1) A				
5	person commits the offense of assault against a water safety				
6	officer if the person:				
7	(a) Intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to a				
8	water safety officer who is engaged in the performance				
9	of duty; or				
10	(b) Recklessly or negligently causes, with a dangerous				
11	instrument, bodily injury to a water safety officer				
12	who is engaged in the performance of duty.				
13	(2) Assault against a water safety officer is a class C				
14	felony.				
15	(3) For purposes of this section, a "water safety officer"				
16	means an employee of any county of the state whose principal				
17	duty is to stand guard over the beaches of the state and				
18	counties to ensure the safety of individuals thereon."
