A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 708-813, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
3	"(1) A person commits the offense of criminal trespass in
4	the first degree if:
5	(a) That person knowingly enters or remains unlawfully:
6	(i) In a dwelling; or
7	(ii) In or upon the premises of a hotel or apartment
8	building;
9	(b) That person:
10	(i) Knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in or upon
11	premises that are fenced or enclosed in a manner
12	designed to exclude intruders; and
13	(ii) Is in possession of a firearm, as defined in
14	section 134-1, at the time of the intrusion; $[\sigma r]$
15	(c) That person enters or remains unlawfully in or upon
16	the premises of any public school as defined in
17	section 302A-101, or any private school, after

2		authorities or a police officer; provided [however,
3		such] that a warning or request to leave shall be
4		unnecessary between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.; or
5	<u>(d)</u>	That person enters or remains unlawfully in or upon
6		the premises of any public housing project, as defined
7		in section 356D-1 or 356D-91, or state low-income
8		housing project, as defined in section 356D-51, after
9		reasonable warning or request to leave by housing
10		authority management or a police officer.
11		For purposes of this paragraph:
12		"Housing authority management" means housing
13		authority employees or agents officially designated by
14		the Hawaii public housing authority to manage the
15		public housing project or to enforce rules relating to
16		the project, including resident managers or managers,
17		tenant monitors, or security guards."
18	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
19	matured,]	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
20	begun befo	ore its effective date.
21	SECT	ION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
