## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL IDENTIFICATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 846-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Application for the registration shall be made in
- 4 person by any adult person or minor over the age of fourteen
- 5 years. In the case of a minor under the age of fourteen years,
- 6 the application shall be made in the minor's behalf by the
- 7 parent, or by another person in loco parentis of such minor who
- 8 can provide proof of quardianship. In the case of an
- 9 incompetent person, the application shall be made by the person
- 10 having the custody or control of or maintaining the incompetent
- 11 person. In the case of a resident of a nursing home, as defined
- 12 in section 457B-2, the application may be made in the resident's
- 13 behalf by the administrator, as defined in section 457B-2, of
- 14 the nursing home in which the resident resides; provided that
- 15 the resident is unable to appear in person to register due to
- 16 infirmity; and provided further that any application made on
- 17 behalf of an infirm nursing home resident include a

- 1 certification by the nursing home resident's physician
- 2 certifying the infirmity of the resident."
- 3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
