

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE ACCESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that codifying the
- 2 practice of making each legislator's voting record publicly
- 3 available online within twenty-four hours of the vote will
- 4 increase public accountability and government transparency.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to increase legislators' public
- 6 accountability by increasing public access to legislators'
- 7 committee and floor voting records.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 21D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 10 and to read as follows:
- 11 "\$21D- Online access to voting records. The voting
- 12 record of each member of the legislature shall be available
- 13 online within twenty-four hours of a vote conducted in committee
- 14 or on the chamber floor. The online information shall be
- 15 organized so that all recorded votes of each member are included
- 16 under the member's name."
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
