## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homeowners, 2 inspectors, and government agencies have difficulty identifying the number of licensed tradespersons performing electrical, 3 plumbing, and elevator work on construction job sites. Further, 4 5 it may be difficult to determine whether the ratio of licensed 6 to unlicensed tradesmen performing electrical, plumbing, and 7 elevator work on construction job sites complies with the 8 requirements of state law. 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide for the identification of licensed electricians, plumbers, and elevator 10 11 mechanics and the enforcement of licensing requirements on 12 construction job sites to protect public safety and comply with 13 state law. 14 SECTION 2. Section 444-9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 15 16 "§444-9.5 Licensing [of]; electrical or plumbing 17 workers [-]; elevator mechanics. 2	electrical [ <del>or</del> ], plumbing, or elevator contractor shall be
3	licensed in accordance with chapter $448E[-]$ for electrical or
4	plumbing work or 448H for elevator mechanic work; provided that
5	this requirement shall not apply to any instance where elevator
6	mechanics are subject to a collective bargaining agreement that
7	contains requirements on the number of licensed elevator
8	mechanics needed to perform licensed work on a construction job
9	site. The board may waive this requirement in any county when
10	there are insufficient licensed electrical [ <del>or</del> ], plumbing, or
11	elevator mechanic workers in that county to comply [herewith.]
12	with this section.
13	(b) All individuals licensed in accordance with chapter
14	448E or 448H, and who are employed on a construction job site by
15	an electrical, plumbing, or elevator contractor, shall visibly
16	display the license issued to them by the department on their
17	person while on the construction job site. Licensed individuals
18	not wearing their license at the time of a site inspection shall

19	not be counted as a licensee to determine compliance with this
