## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$25,000,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4	thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5	2010-2011, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6	the second senatorial district, as follows:
7	1. Pahoa elementary school, Hawaii
8	A. Cafeteria
9	Plans and design \$900,000
10	Construction \$8,100,000
11	Total funding \$9,000,000
12	2. Naalehu elementary and intermediate school, Hawaii
13	A. Administration and library
14	building
15	Plans and design \$1,000,000

17	Total funding \$10,000,000

7	improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at

11	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
12	capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
13	designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
14	provided that:
15	(1) The sums appropriated in items 1 and 2 shall be
16	expended by the department of education; and
17	(2) The sums appropriated in item 3 shall be expended by
18	the University of Hawaii.
