A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in recognition of
- 2 the current economic recession and budget deficit, it will be
- 3 difficult to allocate additional funds to the department of
- 4 education over and above the amount allocated in the General
- 5 Appropriations Act of 2009.
- 6 The legislature is considering other initiatives that would
- 7 restructure Hawaii's educational system for purposes of ensuring
- 8 that the department of education operates efficiently and
- 9 effectively, while promoting student growth and achievement. As
- 10 a result, the board of education should be given additional
- 11 flexibility in using the existing funds to carry out such
- 12 restructuring.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to allow existing funds that
- 14 have been appropriated to the department of education to be
- 15 reprioritized and redistributed as necessary, without affecting
- 16 weighted student formula funds.
- 17 Part III, Act 162, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, SECTION 2.
- 18 is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

6		below the amounts in effect as of July 1, 2010; and
7	(2)	The department of education shall submit a report to
8		the legislature of all the uses of this proviso no
9		later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
10		2011 and 2012 regular sessions."
