BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§26</u>	9- Natural gas utility companies; renewable energy;
5	reporting	requirements. (a) Each natural gas utility company
6	shall sub	mit an annual report to the public utilities commission
7	on or bef	ore June 30 of each year including the following
8	informati	on:
9	<u>(1)</u>	The percentage of natural gas products sold and
10		distributed in the State derived from fossil fuels;
11	(2)	The percentage of natural gas products sold and
12		distributed in the State derived from renewable
13		energy;
14	(3)	The quantity and energy value of natural gas products
15		sold and distributed in the State derived from fossil
16		<pre>fuels; and</pre>

1	(4) The quantity and energy value of natural gas products
2	sold and distributed in the State derived from
3	renewable energy.
4	Within thirty days of receipt of the report, the public
5	utilities commission shall submit a copy of the report to the
6	legislature. The first report shall be submitted no later than
7	June 30, 2011.
8	(b) For the purposes of this section, "renewable energy"
9	means energy generated or produced using methane, renewable
10	diesel, fuel oil, and naptha if sourced from non-petroleum
11	feedstock. Plant oil, algae and algae products, organic
12	material, organic waste, municipal solid waste, waste water, or
13	sewage water may be used as the non-petroleum feedstock."
14	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
