A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION ENERGY INITIATIVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii residents
- 2 should be encouraged to continue purchasing electric vehicles to
- 3 reduce global warming pollutants and greenhouse gas emissions.
- 4 An effective incentive would be to allow electric vehicles
- 5 capable of highway speeds to use high occupancy vehicle lanes
- 6 regardless of whether the vehicle contains the minimum number of
- 7 passengers to lawfully use the high occupancy vehicle lane.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to allow electric vehicles
- 9 capable of highway speeds to use high occupancy vehicle lanes
- 10 without regard to the number of occupants in each vehicle.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 291C-221, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 13 and to read as follows:
- ""Electric vehicle" means the same as section 291-71."
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 291C-221, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending the definition of "high occupancy vehicle
- 17 lane" to read as follows:



- 1 ""High occupancy vehicle lane" means a designated lane of a
- 2 laned roadway where the use of the designated lane is restricted
- 3 to school buses, vehicles carrying at least the minimum number
- 4 of persons designated by the director of transportation on
- 5 official signs and other official traffic-control devices, [and
- 6 to] electric vehicles capable of driving at least fifty-five
- 7 miles per hour without regard to the number of occupants, and
- 8 other vehicles as provided by rules adopted in accordance with
- 9 chapter 91, or by county ordinance."
- 10 SECTION 4. Section 291C-222, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- "(a) The director of transportation by rules adopted in
- 14 accordance with chapter 91, and the counties by ordinance, may
- 15 designate high occupancy vehicle lanes [as] to roadways under
- 16 their respective jurisdictions. The director of transportation,
- 17 by rules adopted in accordance with chapter 91, shall develop
- 18 the means to identify electric vehicles capable of driving at
- 19 least fifty-five miles per hour, including but not limited to
- 20 the use of decals."
- 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:

Report Title:

High Occupancy Vehicle Lanes; Electric Vehicles

Description:

Provides that high occupancy vehicle lanes may be used by electric vehicles capable of driving at least fifty-five miles per hour, regardless of the number of occupants. (SD1)
