A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 264-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§264-101 Vending from highways or scenic lookouts
- 4 prohibited. (a) No person shall park or place a vehicle or
- 5 structure wholly or partly on any highway or at any scenic
- 6 <u>lookout</u> for the purpose of selling the vehicle or structure or
- 7 of selling therefrom or therein any article, service, or thing,
- 8 thereby creating a hazardous condition or a public nuisance or
- 9 in reckless disregard of the risk of creating a hazardous
- 10 condition or public nuisance[+]; provided that vending from a
- 11 scenic lookout may be allowed pursuant to a vending concession
- 12 permit. The department of transportation may remove or require
- 13 the immediate removal of the vehicle or structure from the
- 14 highway.
- (b) For the purposes of this section[, "highway"]:
- 17 shoulder of a public highway as defined in section 264-1.

- 1 "Scenic lookout" includes any area within or adjoining a
- 2 public street, road, or highway that is intended for use by
- 3 motorists as a stopping or parking area attendant to the
- 4 enjoyment of the surrounding scenery or a view."
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
