A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FINANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 140, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 9A. Provided that of the trust funds appropriated
- 4 for beneficiary advocacy (OHA 175), the sum of \$1,010,000 or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010, and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2010-2011, shall be expended to support the building,
- 8 operating, and personnel expenses of seven (7.00 FTE) positions
- 9 for Hookulaiwi: Aha Hoonaauao Oiwi (the center for native
- 10 Hawaiian and indigenous education); provided further that these
- 11 funds shall not be expended for any other purpose; provided
- 12 further that no funds shall be expended unless matched on a
- 13 dollar-for-dollar basis by a trust fund expenditure by the
- 14 department of Hawaiian home lands; and provided further that any
- 15 unexpended funds shall lapse to the trust fund."
- 16 SECTION 2. Act 140, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is
- 17 amended by amending sections 7, 8, and 9 to read as follows:



- 1 "SECTION 7. Provided that of the funds appropriated for beneficiary advocacy (OHA 175), the sum of [\$491,981] \$383,099 2 3 in general funds and [\$491,981] \$600,444 in trust funds for 4 fiscal year 2009-2010 and the sum of [\$473,080] \$257,819 in 5 general funds and [\$473,080] \$581,542 in trust funds for fiscal 6 year 2010-2011 shall provide legal services and legal 7 representation to office of Hawaiian affairs beneficiaries for: 8 [the] 9 The assertion and defense of quiet title action (1)**10** assistance with ahupua'a and kuleana tenant rights, 11 including rights of access and rights to water; [land] 12 Land title assistance, including review of title and (2) 13 genealogy; [preservation] 14 Preservation of traditional and customary practices; (3) 15 [protection] 16 (4) Protection of culturally significant places; 17 [preservation] and 18 Preservation of native Hawaiian land trust (5) 19 entitlements: provided further that notwithstanding section 10-17(e), Hawaii 20 21 Revised Statutes, any funds expended for the purposes of this
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- 1 section shall be in accordance with chapter 103D or 103F, Hawaii
- 2 Revised Statutes, as appropriate.
- 3 SECTION 8. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
- 4 for the office of Hawaiian affairs (OHA 175), the sum of
- $5 \quad [\$87,768]$ \$146,280 or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 6 fiscal year 2009-2010, and the sum of [\$87,768] \$251,658 or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011,
- 8 shall be expended to establish the Achieving the Dream
- 9 Initiative for Native Hawaiian students located at the Hawaii
- 10 Community College; provided further that the funds in fiscal
- 11 year 2009-2010 [and fiscal year 2010-2011] shall be expended to
- 12 fund [three (3.00] five (5.00 FTE) positions; provided further
- 13 that the funds in fiscal year 2010-2011 shall be expended to
- 14 fund nine (9.00 FTE) positions; provided further that these
- 15 funds shall not be expended for any other purpose; provided
- 16 further that no funds shall be expended unless matched on a
- 17 [1:1] dollar-for-dollar basis by a trust fund expenditure by the
- 18 office of Hawaiian affairs; and provided further that any
- 19 unexpended funds shall lapse to the general fund.
- 20 SECTION 9. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
- 21 for the office of Hawaiian affairs (OHA 175), the sum of
- [\$70,000] \$125,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for

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- 1 fiscal year 2009-2010 and the sum of [\$70,000] \$125,000 or so
- 2 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 shall
- 3 be expended to establish a research and training program for
- 4 native Hawaiian students of the Hawaii Institute of Marine
- 5 Biology; provided further that these funds shall not be expended
- 6 for any other purpose; provided further that no funds shall be
- 7 expended unless matched on a [1:1] dollar-for-dollar basis by a
- 8 trust fund expenditure by the office of Hawaiian affairs; and
- 9 provided further that any unexpended funds shall lapse to the
- 10 general fund."
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 2010.
