A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the staff of the
Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund is encountering
difficulties performing its duties. The legislature believes
that these difficulties are the result of an increased and more
complex workload, shortage of personnel, and absence of board
and administrative leadership.

7 The legislature further finds that the enabling law for the 8 voluntary employees' beneficiary association trust, an 9 alternative health-benefits system used by the employee 10 organization for public school teachers, will sunset on July 1, 11 2010. The legislature declares that it does not intend to make 12 the enabling law permanent or extend the sunset date for another 13 pilot testing period.

14 Notwithstanding this intent, the legislature finds that the 15 staff of the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund 16 will experience extreme difficulty assisting in the transition 17 of public school teachers and their dependents from the 18 voluntary employees' beneficiary association trust to the Hawaii SB2395 CD1 LRB 10-2496.doc

Act 245, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, section 2 8, as amended by Act 294, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, section 3 2, as amended by Act 16, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, section 18, as amended by Act 5, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii 4 5 2008, section 1, is amended to read as follows: 6 "SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval, 7 for the purpose of establishing a voluntary employees' 8 beneficiary association trust pilot program in March, 2006 and 9 shall be repealed on [July-1,] December 31, 2010; provided that 10 sections 89-2, 89-3, 89-6, and 89-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 11 are reenacted in the form in which they read on the day before 12 the effective date of this Act; and provided further that the 13 amendments made to section 89-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by Act 14 202, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, shall not be repealed when 15 that section is reenacted on [July 1, 2009.] December 31, 2010." 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii 17 employer-union health benefits trust fund of the State of Hawaii 18 the sum of \$232,542 or so much thereof as may be necessary for 19 fiscal year 2010-2011 for five temporary positions under the 20 Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund to assist in the transition of public employees and their dependents from the 21



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1 voluntary employees' beneficiary association trust to the Hawaii 2 employer-union health benefits trust fund on January 1, 2011. 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii 4 employer-union health benefits trust fund for the purposes of 5 this Act. 6 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii 7 employer-union health benefits trust fund of the State of Hawaii 8 the sum of \$244,359 or so much thereof as may be necessary for 9 fiscal year 2010-2011 for five permanent positions under the 10 Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund to assist in 11 the performance of duties of the trust fund. 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii 13 employer-union health benefits trust fund for the purposes of 14 this Act. 15 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii 16 employer-union health benefits trust fund of the State of Hawaii 17 the sum of \$223,099 or so much thereof as may be necessary for 18 fiscal year 2010-2011 for costs associated with the transition 19 from the voluntary employees' beneficiary association trust to the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund. 20
