BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 40-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) All employees hired on or after July 1, 1998, shall
4	designate a financial institution account into which the State
5	is authorized to deposit the employee's pay[-]; provided that
6	all employees hired prior to July 1, 1998, and who have not
7	designated a financial account into which the State is
8	authorized to deposit the employee's pay, shall designate such
9	an account no later than . The comptroller may waive
10	the requirements of this section for any state employee upon
11	request by the head of the employing department under policies
12	prescribed by the comptroller. The implementation of this
13	section shall not be subject to negotiation under chapter 89."
14	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
