## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 440E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 4 "\$440E- Amateur mixed martial arts. This chapter, with

- 13 SECTION 2. Section 440E-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

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""Amateur mixed martial arts contestant" means a person who

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         SECTION 4. Section 440E-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

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               Any person may apply to the director for a license to

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    martial arts contestant to participate, either directly or
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    indirectly, in any mixed martial arts contest. The application
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    shall be in writing, on a form prescribed by the director, and
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    signed by the applicant. The application shall contain a
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    recital of facts as specified by the director for the director
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    to determine whether or not the applicant possesses the
