A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PARKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 184-3.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "\$184-3.4 State parks special fund. (a) There is
4 established within the state treasury a fund to be known as the
5 state parks special fund, into which shall be deposited:

- 6 (1)All proceeds collected by the state parks programs involving park user fees, any leases or concession 7 agreements, the sale of any article purchased from the 8 department to benefit the state parks programs, or any 9 10 gifts or contributions; provided that proceeds derived from the operation of Iolani Palace shall be used to 11 12 supplement its educational and interpretive programs; 13 and
- 14 (2) Transient accommodations tax revenues pursuant to
 15 section 237D-6.5; provided that these moneys shall be
 16 expended in response to a master plan developed in
 17 coordination with the Hawaii tourism authority.

3	(1) Permanent and temporary staff positions;
4	(2) Planning and development of state parks programs,

8	(4) Operation and maintenance costs of state parks and

10	(5) Administrative costs of the division of state parks.

12	fund, a Diamond Head State Monument sub-account, into which

16	Diamond Head State Monument sub-account for repair, maintenance,
17	and operating costs incurred by the State in the management of
18	the Diamond Head State Monument.
19	(d) There is established within the state parks special
20	fund, a separate sub-account for each county, excluding Kalawao
21	county, into which shall be deposited one hundred per cent of
