A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 343-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "significant effect" to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 ""Significant effect" means the sum of effects on the
- 5 quality of the environment, including actions that irrevocably
- 6 commit a natural resource, curtail the range of beneficial uses
- 7 of the environment, are contrary to the State's environmental
- 8 policies or long-term environmental goals as established by law,
- 9 or adversely affect the economic welfare, social welfare, or
- 10 cultural practices of the community and State. "Significant
- 11 effect" shall not include or require consideration of secondary
- 12 impacts on the environment that may result from government
- 13 action. This latter provision is retroactive to enactment of
- 14 this chapter."
- 15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
